If you find yourself in a dangerous situation, or you suspect someone else is in one, we want to help you.

THESE ARE SOME SIGNS THAT CAN HELP YOU RECOGNIZE IF YOU ARE IN A DANGEROUS SITUATION:

- You are offered a job by someone you don't know.
- You are offered free transportation, accommodation, or travel documents.
- Your identification documents are taken away from you.
- You are forced to do something against your will, such as having sex.
- + You are not allowed to go to the doctor, talk to authorities, or ask for help.
- You are forced to sleep and work at the same place.

- You are treated in an aggressive manner, physically or verbally.
- You are told that you have a debt to pay, or that you have to pay back money.
- + You are not allowed to move freely or communicate with other people.
- You don't get paid for your job or they keep a significant part of your salary.
- You are not allowed breaks while working.
